

UK Spouse Visa: A Complete Guide

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Eligibility for a UK Spouse Visa

UK Spouse Visa Application Process

Step 2: Biometrics Appointment

Book and attend an appointment at a visa application center to provide fingerprints and a photo.

Step 3: Document Submission

Upload or submit all required documents.

Step 4: Decision Waiting Time

Processing times vary but usually take 8–12 weeks for applications outside the UK.

UK Spouse Visa Extension & Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR)

After living in the UK for 2.5 years on a Spouse Visa, you can apply for an extension. After 5 years, you may be eligible for ILR (Indefinite Leave to Remain), granting permanent residency.

Common Reasons for UK Spouse Visa Refusal

Insufficient financial evidence

Invalid or missing documents

Failure to meet the English language requirement

Lack of genuine relationship proof
